- Cannot be disabled without impairing site performance.
- 3.2 Performance and Analytics Cookies
- Help us understand user behaviour on the site.
- Provide data on pages visited, time spent, and user journey.
- Use anonymised data and are used solely for improving services.
- 3.3 Functionality Cookies
- Remember your preferences, such as language or region.
- Enhance website customisation and personalisation.
- 3.4 Third-Party Cookies
- May be set by third-party services integrated into our site (e.g., YouTube, Google Maps).
- Controlled by those providers under their own policies.
- 4. HOW WE USE COOKIES

We use cookies to:

- Improve website speed and reliability.
- Analyse usage patterns and optimise design.
- Store login credentials (optional).

- Ensure security and fraud prevention.
- 5. COOKIE CONSENT
- On your first visit, you are prompted to consent to non-essential cookies.
- You may adjust or withdraw consent using the cookie banner or browser settings.
- Essential cookies do not require consent.

6. MANAGING COOKIES

You can manage or disable cookies by adjusting your browser settings:

- Chrome: Settings > Privacy and Security > Site Settings > Cookies
- Firefox: Options > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data
- Safari: Preferences > Privacy
- Edge: Settings > Site permissions > Cookies and site data
